

Alternative Instructional Strategies for Level 1 - Sample TBYB

Level 1 - Lesson 14 Identifying Common Nouns	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Make a list of common nouns in your Writer's Notebook.● Write a sentence using some of the common nouns from your list. Underline the common nouns.● For added practice, read a picture book with the student. As you read, have them point out the nouns.
Level 1 - Lesson 23 Parts of a Paragraph	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use green, purple, and blue crayons (color very lightly!) or colored pencils to highlight the parts of the paragraph on pages 110 and 111. Touch the indent.
Level 1 - Lesson 26 Closing Sentence	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● After completing the paragraph on page 117, use green, purple, and blue crayons or colored pencils to LIGHTLY highlight the parts of the paragraph. Touch the indent.● Have the student create a colorful poster that shows the parts of a paragraph. They may hang the poster in their learning space for future reference.
Level 1 - Lesson 30 Paragraph Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Help the student brainstorm a list of things he/she likes to do. Add the list to the Writer's Notebook. Choose one of these things to be the topic for Lesson 30.● Go over the Paragraph Checklist with the student prior to having them check their paragraph to ensure they understand how to "self-check" their work.
