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COURSE DESCRIPTION

The College Application Essay Guide is designed for college-bound students who are preparing their college applications. 
This product is a general guide. When it comes to writing prompts, formatting requirements, and submission instructions, students should *know and follow the guidelines of the college/program to which they are applying*.


A Note about Common App:

COURSE LAYOUT


The College Application Essay Guide is divided into seven major **sections**, followed by a collection of example essays. Sections 1-7 delve into what an application essay is and how to effectively craft one. The example essays in the latter half of the Guide are present for students to review as needed.








Each section is divided into individual **lessons**.




Each lesson contains **text** that the student should read before watching the corresponding **video** lesson. The student will be reminded to watch the video lesson by the presence of a **video icon** at the beginning of each text lesson.



Most text lessons end with an **activity** for the student to complete. Students should follow the instructions listed to complete the activity.




These activities are modeled in the video lesson. An **example** of the completed activity is included on the pages after the activity. The content of these examples corresponds to what was modeled in the video lesson.




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At the end of the textbook, nine **example essays** are included for the student to reference as needed, complete with annotations explaining what makes the essay effective.
